1 Magic City Sprinkler

Roanoke, VA · ~25–60 staff (est.) · Founded 1971 · high confidence

Family firm since 1971, now run by the third and fourth generations. Inspection and backflow testing add recurring work. Roanoke Valley anchor, mid-band size.

3 J&D Sprinkler

Clayton, NC · ~45–65 staff (est.) · Founded 1986 · high confidence

Graham family since 1986, with three family owners named on the site. 58 jobs in 2020 PPP data, a separate inspection team, licensed in NC, SC, VA and GA.

5 Williams Fire Sprinkler

Williamston, NC · ~40–60 staff (est.) · Founded 1972 · high confidence

Family-owned since 1972; 54 jobs in 2020 PPP data. Alarm monitoring and inspections add recurring lines across eastern NC. Officer data is dated; confirm leadership first.

2 Crews & Gregory Fire Sprinkler

Midlothian, VA · ~25–40 staff (est.) · Founded 1996 · high confidence

Co-founder in the trade since 1972 still sells while a second leader runs it as President, so succession is underway. 29 jobs in 2020 PPP data; dedicated inspections manager.

4 Fire Sprinkler, Ltd.

Rustburg, VA · ~20–35 staff (est.) · Founded 1988 · med confidence

Family-owned since 1988; D&B lists 27 staff. In-house fire protection engineer, and offices in Rustburg and Chatham on US-29, right on the VA–NC corridor.

How we sourced this

- Virginia DPOR contractor lists (sprinkler and suppression specialties, first-license dates), company About and team pages, BBB profiles, public mirrors of SCC / SOS officer records.
- Headcount bands are estimates from public proxies (2020 PPP jobs-retained figures, directory counts, team pages), not payroll data. 📌 marks names that may sit under the 15-employee floor.
- Excluded as platform-owned: Pye-Barker, VSC / Markel, Eagle Fire, Summit, Guardian, Marmic / Fire Solutions, SuperHero and Impact Fire brands, per public deal announcements.
- Public records don't show revenue, inspection share or intent to sell. Owners are named only from public pages; contacts are held back for the paid sheet.

Threatt Inc.	Battleboro, NC	15–40 (estimate)	1952 (brand)	Not confirmed in public sources used	Confirm ownership: the brand dates to 1952 but the current corporation was formed in 2018. Plumbing is a large share of the work.
Yadkin Valley Fire Protection	Thomasville, NC	25–35 (PPP 2020: 28 jobs)	—	Not named in public sources used	Confirm ownership: size fits, but no owner or independence signal in public sources.
